### **Bill 21, the *Securities Amendment Act 2007***

April 17, 2007

On April 12, 2007 Bill 21, the *Securities Amendment Act 2007* received third reading in the Legislative Assembly of Alberta. The amendments advance the harmonization and streamlining of securities legislation across Canada.

A number of the amendments will support proposed National Instrument 31-103 *Registration Requirements* and the registration provisions of proposed National Instrument 11-102 *Passport System*. These amendments will come into force on proclamation, which is expected to be concurrent with the implementation of NI 31-103.

The other provisions in Bill 21 are designed to enhance harmonization or are technical or housekeeping in nature.
